Founder of the C12 Group, LLC

Before coming to Florida and ultimately founding The C12 Group in 1992, Buck served as Board Director and Vice-President of Sales of the S.H. Mack Company in St. Charles, Illinois. During his ten-year association with the Mack Company, he led a ten-fold increase in sales and was instrumental in the global development of a successful Christ-centered business which was later acquired by a large public

company. During this time, the Mack Company was a founding member of The Fellowship of Companies for Christ International (FCCI).

A graduate of Davidson College cum laude in economics and Duke Law School, Black served as the third woman president of the North Carolina Association of Trial Lawyers and the fourth woman president of the North Carolina Bar Association. She is only the second lawyer in history to serve as president of both organizations.

Black is a frequent lawyer educator and motivational speaker. She is a Trustee Emeritus of Hood Theological Seminary and has served on many non-profit boards and on many international mission trips. She is a member of the Women's Presidents Organization and C12, Christian CEOs and Business Owners' Group.


